

**RV Mobile Power LLC., U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND
CALIFORNIA EXHAUST EMISSIONS CONTROL WARRANTY STATEMENT**

YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the California Air Resources Board and RV Mobile Power LLC., are pleased to explain the exhaust emissions control system warranty on your 2021, 2022 and 2023 model year small off-road engine. In California, new equipment that uses small off-road engines must be designed, built, and equipped to meet the State's stringent anti-smog standards. RV Mobile Power LLC must warrant the emissions control system on your small off-road engine for the periods of time listed below provided there has been no abuse, neglect or improper maintenance of your small off-road engine leading to the failure of the emissions control system.

Your emissions control system may include parts such as the carburetor or fuel-injection system, the ignition system, catalytic converter, valves, canisters, filters, clamps and other associated components. Also included may be hoses, belts, connectors, and other emission-related assemblies.

Where a warrantable condition exists, RV Mobile Power LLC will repair your small off-road engine at no cost to you including diagnosis, parts and labor.

In other states, new small off-road engine must be designed, built and equipped at the time of sale to meet the U.S. EPA regulations for small off-road engine.

MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY COVERAGE:

The exhaust emissions control system on your small off-road engine is warranted for two years. If any emissions-related part on your small off-road engine is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced by RV Mobile Power LLC.

OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES:

(a) As the small off-road engine owner, you are responsible for the performance of the required maintenance listed in your owner's manual. RV Mobile Power LLC recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your small off-road engine, but RV Mobile Power LLC cannot deny warranty coverage solely for the lack of receipts or for your failure to ensure the performance of all scheduled maintenance.

(b) As the small off-road engine owner, you should be aware that RV Mobile Power LLC may deny you warranty coverage if your small off-road engine or a part has failed due to abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance or unapproved modifications.

(c) You are responsible for presenting your small off-road engine to a RV Mobile Power LLC distribution center or service center as soon as the problem exists. The warranty repairs shall be completed in a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 30 days.

DEFECTS WARRANTY REQUIREMENTS:

- (a) The warranty period begins on the date the engine or equipment is delivered to an ultimate purchaser.
- (b) General Emissions Warranty Coverage. RV Mobile Power LLC warrants to the ultimate purchaser and each subsequent owner that the engine is:
 - (1) Designed, built, and equipped so as to conform with all applicable regulations adopted by US EPA & Air Resources Board; And
 - (2) Free from defects in materials and workmanship that causes the failure of a warranted part for a period of two years.
- (c) The warranty on emissions-related parts will be interpreted as below:
 - (1) Any warranted part that is not scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the written instructions required by subsection (d) must be warranted for the warranty period defined in Subsection(b)(2). If any such part fails during the period of warranty coverage, it must be repaired or replaced by RV Mobile Power LLC according to Subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under the warranty must be warranted for the remaining warranty period.
 - (2) Any warranted part that is scheduled only for regular inspection in the written instructions required by subsection(d) must be warranted for the warranty period defined in Subsection(b)(2). A statement in such written instructions to the effect of “repair or replace as necessary” will not reduce the period of warranty coverage. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty must be warranted for the remaining warranty period.
 - (3) Any warranted part that is scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the written instructions required by subsection (d) must be warranted for the period of time prior to the first scheduled replacement point for that part. If the part fails prior to the first scheduled replacement, the part must be repaired or replaced by RV Mobile Power LLC according to Subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty must be warranted for the remainder of the period prior to the first scheduled replacement point for the part.
 - (4) Repair or replacement of any warranted part under the warranty must be performed at no charge to the owner at a warranty station.
 - (5) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection (4) above, warranty services or repairs must be provided at all RV Mobile Power LLC distribution centers that are franchised to service the subject engines.
 - (6) The owner must not be charged for diagnostic labor that leads to the determination that a warranted part is in fact defective provided that such diagnostic work is performed at a warranty station.
 - (7) RV Mobile Power LLC is liable for damages to other engine components proximately caused by a failure under warranty of any warranted part.
 - (8) Throughout the emissions warranty period defined in Subsection (b)(2), RV Mobile Power LLC must maintain a supply of warranted parts sufficient to meet the expected demand for such parts.
 - (9) Any replacement part may be used in the performance of any warranty maintenance or repairs and must be provided without charge to the owner such use will not reduce the warranty obligations of RV Mobile Power LLC.
 - (10) Add-on or modified parts that are not exempted by the Air Resources Board may not be used. The use of any non-exempted add-on or modified parts will be grounds for disallowing a warranty claim. RV Mobile Power LLC will not be liable to warrant failures of warranted parts caused by the use of a non-exempted add-on or modified part.
 - (11) RV Mobile Power LLC issuing the warranty shall provide any documents that describe that manufacturer’s warranty procedures or policies within five working days of request by the US EPA & Air Resources Board.

EMISSION WARRANTY PARTS LIST

(1) Fuel Metering System

- (i) Carburetor and internal parts (and/or pressure regulator or fuel injection system).
- (ii) Air/fuel ratio feedback and control system.
- (iii) Cold start enrichment system.

(2) Air induction system

- (i) Controlled hot air intake system.
- (ii) Intake manifolds.
- (iii) Air filter.

(3) Ignition System

- (i) Spark Plugs.
- (ii) Magneto or electronic ignition system.
- (iii) Spark advance/retard system.

(4) Exhaust Gas Recirculation (EGR) System

- (i) EGR valve body, and carburetor spacer if applicable.
- (ii) EGR rate feedback and control system.

(5) Air Injection System

- (i) Air pump or pulse valve.
- (ii) Valves affecting distribution of flow.
- (iii) Distribution manifold.

(6) Catalyst or Thermal Reactor System

- (i) Catalytic converter.
- (ii) Thermal reactor.
- (iii) Exhaust manifold.

(7) Particulate Controls

- (i) Traps, filters, precipitators, and any other device used to capture particulate emissions.

(8) Miscellaneous Items Used in Above Systems

- (i) Electronic controls
- (ii) Vacuum, temperature, and time sensitive valves and switches.
- (iii) Hoses, belts, connectors, and assemblies.

RV Mobile Power LLC will furnish with each new engine written instructions for the maintenance and use of the engine by the owner.

****Current and following model year will be updated annually in the warranty statement provided to the consumer. For example, in 2018 model year, 2018-2019 will be specified.***
